Job racket: UoP official gets notice

Pune: A major scam in recruitment of Class III and IV employees rocked the University of Pune (UoP) on Wednesday. The university has served a show cause notice to a section officer for allegedly forging marks of written examination of nine candidates.

More skeletons are likely to stumble out of the closet after UoP's fact-finding committee completes its probe into the alleged scam. The racket came to light on Wednesday after some employees of the university blackened the face of the suspected section officer working in non-teaching administration section. Vice Chancellor Narendra Jadhav admitted the existence of the scam at a press conference held late on Wednesday evening.

Job racket: UoP official gets notice

UoP is in process of filling up the huge backlog of teaching and non-teaching staff. It conducted exams for clerical posts of Class III and other posts of Class IV on February 21. Over 1,700 candidates had appeared for 41 non-teaching posts.

UoP publishes marks of written exams on its website for transparency. However, this measure itself had leakages. The SET section, which is entrusted with conduction of written exams, complained to the vice chancellor about anomaly in marks put on the

website. UoP officials then tallied marks scored in the written papers with marks listed on website. It was found that marks of seven candidates had been increased. The increase was as huge as 80 to 100 marks, which could have made these candidates eligible for straight recruitment.

When UoP officials probed further, two more cases were found, informed the Vice Chancellor. Of the nine cases, parents of two candidates are employed by the UoP.

The Vice Chancellor said, "Prima facie, it is found that an

पुणे दि. २५ (प्रतिनिधी) - एम.फिल.च्या विविध शाखांमधील प्रत्येकी विद्यार्थ्यांना शिष्यवृत्ती देण्याचा प्राप्तीचा निर्णय रद्द करून पुणे विद्यापीठाच्या व्यवस्थापन परिषदेने प्राप्ती काही अटीची पूर्तता करणाऱ्या सर्वच विद्यार्थ्यांना शिष्यवृत्ती देण्याचे ठरविले आहे. कुलगुरु डॉ. नरेंद्र जाधव यांनी पत्रकार परिषदेत ही माहिती दिली.

विद्यापीठ व्यवस्थापन परिषदेने यापूर्वीचा बैठकीत 'एम.फिल.'च्या वेळ ४ विद्यार्थ्यांना शिष्यवृत्ती देण्याचा निर्णय घेतला होता. त्याविरोधात विद्यार्थ्यांनी अटोलन केले होते. त्यामुळे आजच्या बैठकीत त्यावर फेरविचार करून 'एम.फिल.'च्या सर्वच विद्यार्थ्यांना

शिष्यवृत्ती देण्याचा निर्णय घेण्यात आला. मात्र, शिष्यवृत्तीचा रक्कमपर टाळण्यासाठी विद्यार्थ्यांवर काही उर्दी लादण्यात आल्याचे त्यांनी सांगितले.

या एकत्रित समितीने घेतलेल्या आढाव्यानंतर विद्यापीठाने १९९६ पासून २००४ पर्यंतच्या अकराऊठ्ठा मजुरी दिली आहे. त्यानुसार आठ वर्षांचे अॅडिटेड स्टेटमेंट आणि सर्व विद्यापीठांचा 'कॉमन अकाउंटिंग कोड' तयार करण्यात आला आहे. विद्यापीठात उभारण्यात आलेल्या मराठी भाषा संवर्धन, आदिवासी अध्ययन, आणोबाणी व्यवस्थापन आणि दूरशिक्षण या ४ केंद्रासाठी पदे मंजूर करण्यात आली असल्याची माहिती कुलगुरुंनी दिली.

All M Phil students to get stipend

No decision for postgraduate centres yet

Pune: University of Pune (UoP) has finally accepted the demand of M Phil students and announced a stipend to all 240 students doing the course at the UoP campus this year.

The management council of the university met on Wednesday. The council approved the change in the earlier decision, which had restricted stipend to first four students of each department. This would have left 80 students without benefit of the stipend.

Students at the university had protested against the restrictions last week.

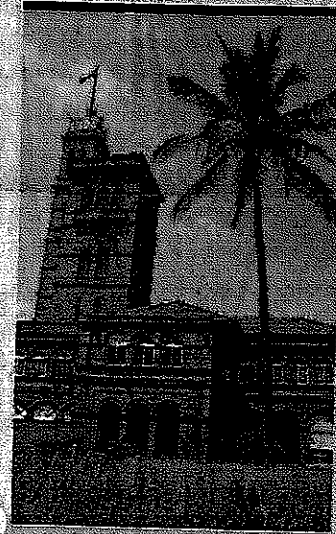
The management council meeting removed the restrictions, but made it clear that students would be offered M Phil only if they fulfilled the norms set down by the university.

The norms to be followed by the M Phil students involve obtaining a progress report from the head of department.

At present, the university offers Rs 3,000 per month as stipend for the first year of the M Phil course.

The university, however did not take any decision about M Phil students at postgraduate centres outside its campus.

UoP to annul EIL contract
The management council gave its go-ahead to walk out of contract with Engineers India Limited for construction of 15 new buildings.

The management council meeting made it clear that students would be offered M Phil only if they fulfilled the norms

Vice Chancellor Narendra Jadhav claimed that the university would try to recover the maximum amount of Rs 20 lakh given to EIL for initial expenses.

The university will start construction of 15 buildings after the EIL contract is legally terminated, he added.
